Isaac Morrow died at home of daughter Mrs. DAJ Chambers near McGirk 22 Mar 1898. Born in Macon County Missouri (sic) in 1822, he came to Moniteau County in 1882, settling a little east of town, Two years ago he moved to the Confederate Home where he lived until last October.

Two daughters came to help care for him in his last weeks: Mrs May Powell of near Jamestown and Mrs. Nellie Glick. Two sons were called from Macon County and Camden County, but arrived after his death. A member of the Christian Church for 45 years he was buried in the Martin Cemetery north of the city.
